1. Ian Yard-Smith joined the meeting. Ian introduced himself, spoke about CER and he intends to meet with Principals of RI and PJP schools. He recognises the need to build the service of CER. The transition to a different cost recovery method has new challenges. The intention is to provide a legal service. EPC members stated the need to rebuild the relationship so negotiations can proceed in a more effective way.

2. Catholic Schools NSW. Danielle Cronin attended the meeting briefly and she provided updates on

- a. NESA and the registration of accredited professional development. This has been driven politically. HALT is still under review.
- b. COVID 19 - School HSC celebrations were a significant part of the conversation.
- c. Choice and Affordability Fund. The distribution of monies is underway.
